## **Application Requirements / Process**

- 1. All requests for variation of firebreaks must be submitted in writing using the application form and submitted to email: <a href="mailto:emergencyservices@esperance.wa.gov.au">emergencyservices@esperance.wa.gov.au</a>, in person or by post.
- 2. Application must be received by 24 September. Late applications will not be considered.
- 3. Payment of fee. Payment must be received for the application to proceed to assessment.
- 4. Application must be submitted by the landowner or by a person authorised to act on their behalf.
- 5. Assessment will be undertaken by an Authorised Shire of Esperance Officer.
- 6. Due to the restricted timeframes for assessment, an applicant has 5 business days to respond to any further information requests. Failure to respond within 5 business days may result in the application being refused.
- 7. The Authorised Officer has the right to grant or refuse an application and alter or add any conditions to an application.
- 8. Failure to comply within timeframes provided by an Authorised Officer will result in the refusal of the application.
- 9. The Authorised Officer may refer the application to the local Bush Fire Brigade for consideration of the proposed firebreak variation.
- 10. The Authorised Officer may refer the application to neighbouring properties who may be given the opportunity to lodge a submission regarding the application.
- 11. Internal referral of the application this may include Ranger Services, Development Services, or Asset Management.
- 12. Notification of outcome approval or refusal of the requested firebreak variation, provided in writing.
- 13. If an application is not approved or refused, the landowner has 14 days to comply with the requirements in the Fire Hazard Reduction Notice.
