Terms and Conditions for Hire

These conditions explain what you agree to when you hire our Accessible Portable Toilet or BBQ Trailer.

1. What You're Hiring

You are hiring either or both of the following;

- Accessible Portable Toilet - We supply the equipment, deliver it, and collect it when you're finished. You must make sure the delivery location is safe, level, and easy for us to access.
- BBQ Trailer – you collect and return when you've finished.

2. Payment

Hire fees must be paid before delivery unless we agree otherwise.

There is no bond, but you are responsible for any damage.

3. Care of the Equipment

While the equipment is with you, you must;

- Take good care of it
- Use it for its intended purpose
- Keep it secure
- Make sure no one moves it (especially the toilet unit) once it has been placed

4. Cleaning

You have two options;

- Option 1: You clean it;
You return the equipment in a clean condition including the tank pumped out for the accessible toilet.
- Option 2: You pay the cleaning fee
 - If you pay the cleaning fee, we will take care of the cleaning after pickup.

If the equipment comes back dirty and you did not pay the cleaning fee, we will invoice you for cleaning.

5. Damage, Loss, or Theft

You are responsible for any damage, loss, or theft during your hire period.

If something is damaged, you must pay for repair or replacement.

Please contact us as soon as you notice any problem.

6. Accessible Portable Toilet – Special Rules

To prevent blockages or damage;

- Only toilet paper goes down the toilet. No rubbish, nappies, wipes, food scraps, or chemicals.
- If the toilet becomes overly full because of heavy use, extra pump-out fees may apply.

7. BBQ Trailer – Special Rules

When using the BBQ trailer, you must;

- Follow basic fire safety
- Keep food scraps, oils, and fat from blocking or damaging the trailer
- Make sure the BBQ is turned off after use
- Follow local fire bans or restrictions
- You are responsible for any fire-related damage caused by misuse.

8. Safety

Please use the equipment safely and supervise children around both the toilet unit and the BBQ trailer.

9. If You Need to Cancel

If you need to cancel, please let us know as early as possible.
