- Agree to enter into a Management Agreement over Munglinup Beach Campground with Munglinup Beach Trust trading as Munglinup Beach Caravan Park
- Waive fees applicable for a stall holder's permit for Esperance for Participating Businesses for Garage Sale Trail this year

The Shire of Esperance would like to thank members of the Esperance community involved in community planting over the past month.

Over 60 volunteers, including Esperance Scouts, turned out for National Tree Day at Lake Monjingup where over 3000 seedlings were planted. Eighty students and 23 parents from Castletown Primary school planted nearly 1000 trees at Castletown Quays and students from Cascade Primary School planted around 600 seedlings at Quagi Beach.




The Shire has planted over 11000 seedlings as part the winter planting program funded by State Natural Resource Management and Coastwest with the help of many community groups and volunteers.
