

## Ordinary Council Meeting Resolutions

Ordinary Council Meetings are always open to the public and provide an opportunity for community members to ask questions and hear what is happening in Council. This week's Ordinary Council Meeting took place on Tuesday 28 August resolving to:

- Endorse the Replacement Jetty Draft Concept Design Report for public comment for a period of 21 days
- Commit \$1,495,601 for the supply and installation of twelve road grids, including the associated road and signage works, for the Esperance Extension to the State Barrier Fence project. This commitment is over four years, starting in the 2019/20 financial year, and will be part of the annual road construction program
- Accept the management of Reserve 35069 and agree to continued usage by the Cascade Primary School at agreed dates and times.
- Endorse the CSRFF Small Grant Funding applications
- Waive the fees associated with utilising the Civic Centre for the memorial Service to be held in honour of the late Rev. Douglas Murray (OAM).
