Please follow the Code of Conduct below for the comfort and safety of everyone.

Be Considerate

- of all customers and staff in the Library
- tidy up after yourself
- talk quietly and use mobile phones outside
- do not visit the Library if you are unwell

Be Respectful

- towards staff and other customers
- of Library spaces, collections and equipment
- by wearing appropriate clothing and footwear in the Library
- use G-rated language and good manners at all times
- aggressive and abusive behaviour will not be tolerated

Be Responsible

- for your behaviour and personal belongings
- for anyone in your care
- children left unsupervised can become distressed, bored or disruptive. Staff are unable to supervise children who are left alone in the Library, and there is a risk they may leave, hurt themselves or be approached by strangers.
We recommend children are not left in the Library unattended
- use designated Library power points; keep cords from being trip hazards

Be Cyber Smart

- protect your logins and passwords
- read and follow the Computer and Wi-Fi Terms and Conditions
- do not access inappropriate material from the Library internet service
- report any cyber safety issues to staff
