AQUATIC AREA TEMPORARILY CLOSED

The aquatic area at the Bay of Isles Leisure Centre will be temporarily closed until urgent maintenance on the boilers can be completed. The maintenance planned for today has determined a more significant problem which needs to be remedied as soon as possible.

The boilers, which are responsible for heating the water in all the pools in the centre, have stopped working and the parts required are not available in Esperance. Once the parts are received and fitted it will take time for the pools to return to temperatures patrons will be comfortable swimming in.

All swimming lessons will be postponed until next week, all participants are currently being advised of the delay.

CEO Matthew Scott said "We apologise for the disruption this will cause everyone keen to start their swimming lessons, have a swim, complete some hydrotherapy rehabilitation or just to relax in the spa. Unfortunately the closure has had to extend and it may be up to a week before we can reopen this aquatic section of the Bay of Isles."
