Objective:

To set guidelines under which Council will permit persons living on board vessels in the harbour.

Policy:

Subject to compliance with the Council's requirements regarding ablution facilities, effluent holding tanks and refuse disposal, Council does not object to living on board to a maximum of three (3) weeks at any one time in the Bandy Creek Boat Harbour or the Marina. No vessel shall be occupied for a total of more than 6 weeks within any 6 month period.

Should a greater number than three (3) weeks be required at any one time then the Director External Services or in his absence the Chief Executive Officer be given delegated authority to approve such applications.

Irrespective of the above approval is required for any vessel that is proposed to be lived on in the Bandy Creek Boat Harbour or the Marina.
