CONDITIONS ASSESSMENTS UNDERWAY FOR THREE JETTIES IN ESPERANCE

The Shire of Esperance would like to advise the community that an assessment of all three town jetties is currently being undertaken and will continue for the next week. These assessments will look at the current condition and ongoing maintenance requirements of the Tanker Jetty, James Street Jetty and the Boat Ramp Jetty. These are essential to ensure the structural integrity of the jetties continue to provide a safe and secure environment for all users.

As a result of the assessments some sections may need to be closed in the interim period due to identified safety and structural concerns. Further information will be provided to the community as it becomes available.

The information detailed in these reports will inform Council and the community about the current condition of all three jetty's and guide future maintenance planning and processes.

Shire President Victoria Brown stated "These assessments are necessary on structures that include public accessibility. Council understands how important all three jetties are to the community and it is for this reason we need to monitor their condition. We would like to thank you for your patience while the work is being undertaken and we will make sure you are kept informed of what is happening and the final results in the report."
