Free wifi!

Esperance is keeping up with the times with the installation of wifi in the town centre! You will be able to access the wifi for free from your own device along the Foreshore between the Whale Tail and the Skate Park, along James and Andrew Streets between the Esplanade and Dempster Street and along Dempster Street between James and Andrew Streets.

The Shire has worked with the Goldfields Esperance Development Commission and the Esperance Chamber of Commerce and Industry in the planning of this project. Installation of the wifi network has been made possible through Royalties for Regions funding received as part of the Supertowns program. This is a two-year trial with high speeds being achieved by connection to the National Broadband Network.

When you connect to the network you will be asked to agree to terms and conditions. You will have access to a two-hour session and site restrictions and download limits will apply.

Shire President Victoria Brown said, "This is a fantastic way to encourage people to spend more time in our town centre. You can capture your fantastic photos and share them online straight away too!"
