At last! A Jetty for Esperance!

The Shire of Esperance has secured \$4m in Round 3 of the Federal Government's Building Better Regions Fund for the new jetty. The Shire submitted their business case and application in November last year.

Now that this application has been successful, the Shire can begin the process of building the jetty. Letters of support were received from various state agencies, political representatives and community groups and were included with the Shire's application. This included 17 letters from local, regional, state and federal agencies, and 14 from community and representative groups.

Shire President Victoria Brown said, "This is fantastic news. It will allow us to take another huge step forward, and get the Esperance Community a jetty. This announcement is very important for our community and I encourage everyone to support this exciting project as we move forward.

"Thank you to all those who wrote letters of support for the Shire's application and to those who participated in the surveys to help achieve this outcome. Congratulations also to the Shire staff members who worked hard to ensure the application was of the highest calibre.

"Now we move on to completing the Final Detailed Design and getting ready to issue tenders for the build."
