Jetty Tender Closed

The Shire of Esperance Tender for Construction of the Esperance Replacement Jetty closed at noon today. There were multiple tenders received from three tenderers. This includes compliant tenders and alternatives.

The tender sought submissions from suitably qualified and experienced contractors to construct the new Esperance Replacement Jetty based on the Detailed Design approved by the Heritage Council of WA.

The Tender panel will commence the assessment of all three tenders against a range of criteria to select the tenderers who have been able to best meet the requirements outlined. The assessment will commence immediately with a recommendation being presented to Council for endorsement on completion. The assessment panel for the tender includes three Shire Officers with engineering and financial backgrounds and an independent engineer from GHD Group Pty Ltd.

CEO Matthew Scott said, "We are pleased to have received multiple submissions from construction firms with experience in this area. This is a positive step in the process we have been following to ensure the Esperance Community have access to a recreational jetty. All tenders submitted will be evaluated against the specifications outlined, the price and their construction methodology. Once the panel have assessed all submissions they will make a recommendation to Council. The community will be kept up to date as to when this will occur.

"No further information on the tenders received can be provided at this time as we have not had an opportunity to review the submissions at this early stage.

"As with all tenders we are not at liberty to discuss individual tenders until after this item is presented to Council and a decision made."
