Jetty Design Tender Awarded

A tender to undertake the Detailed Design Development for the replacement of the Esperance Tanker Jetty was awarded at the March Ordinary Council Meeting.

The tender was awarded to a design consortium led by heritage architects, H+H Architects, who will deliver a detailed design of a Jetty that will meet the needs of the Esperance community and the Heritage Council of Western Australia. The successful tender was awarded for \$334,800 (excluding GST).

The selection of H+H Architects was assessed by a panel with the other submissions, and included representatives from Southern Ports and the Department of Transport. H+H Architects will work with the Shire, Jetty Replacement Working Group, Department of Planning, Lands and Heritage and Heritage Council of WA. The panel assessed eight submissions based on the scope of works outlined in the tender.

CEO Matthew Scott said, "Now that a tender has been awarded, the next step will be for H+H Architects to develop the draft design concept, to take us from where we are now, to delivering a detailed design accepted by the Heritage Council of WA and ready for a construction tender. This will allow the Shire to be in a position to apply for funding.

"We would like to thank the representatives from Southern Ports and the Department of Transport who provided feedback on the tender assessment panel."

Shire President Victoria Brown said, "We are moving forward one step at a time. It will be exciting to see the design develop and come to life. The new jetty will be something that our community and visitors can enjoy into the future, whilst recognising the historical story of our jetty."
