ESPERANCE PARKING, TRAFFIC, AND PEDESTRIAN STRATEGY

Council resolved to open The Esperance Town Centre Parking, Traffic and Pedestrian Strategy for public comment to allow for community submission within a 21 day period.

Shire President Victoria Brown said "We as a council wanted to make sure that for one final time the community were aware that the strategy was going through and this was their opportunity to have another say."

As part of the Esperance Town Centre Revitalisation Master Plan 2015 -2035 parking was identified as an important issue in the town centre. A parking strategy has now been developed which also incorporates traffic and pedestrian movement.

The Esperance Town Centre Parking, Traffic, and Pedestrian Strategy was drafted by Opus International Consultants and the strategy is broken up into both long and short term stages.

CEO Matthew Scott said "This is not something that is going to happen all at once, it will happen in stages over the next 20 years."

"We want to make the town pedestrian friendly by getting people out of their cars and walking through the town centre," CEO Matthew Scott said.
