Next Steps on Jetty

At a Special Council Meeting today a Request for Quotation for the Esperance Tanker Jetty Reconstruction Feasibility Report was considered behind closed doors.

Shire President Victoria Brown said, "Council deemed that the quotes received were excessive and would not provide any additional value considering previous reports and decisions on providing a recreational jetty for our community.

"Rather than prolong the situation, Council would like to further develop the design for a replacement Jetty with a Heritage Architect as per the Heritage Council's advice."

CEO Matthew Scott said, "Given this resolution, further conversations will be had with the Heritage Council to move the project forward."

The resolution is:

That Council

- 1. Not accept any quotes in regards to RFQ 0095-17 – Esperance Tanker Jetty Reconstruction Feasibility Report.*
- 2. Determine that a reconstruction to 512m is not a "prudent and feasible" option given the information provided in the RFQ, and given the reports already collated, advise the Heritage Council accordingly and seek their feedback.*
- 3. Direct the CEO to seek an RFQ from the 3 recommended Heritage Architects to further develop the design for a replacement Jetty that delivers the best heritage outcomes whilst meeting our Community needs.*
- 4. Request the CEO to approach the Goldfields Esperance Development Commission for assistance in working with relevant state agencies on this matter.*
