



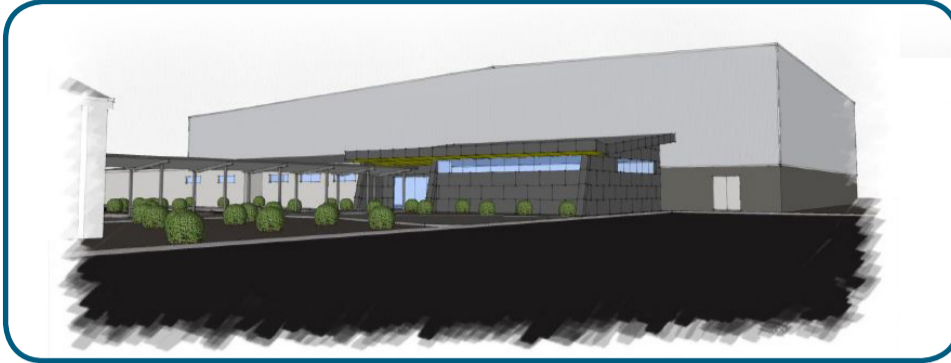

Concept designs are now available for the Indoor Sports Stadium. These plans will be presented to potential funding bodies in the coming weeks. Cost estimates are still being collated and will be included with the plan once completed.



If funding is approved the Shire should be notified by early 2017 after which we will commence with detailed design development.

Ordinary Council Meeting Agenda

This month's Ordinary Council Meeting will take place on Tuesday 23 August at 4pm in Council Chambers for Council to consider the following recommendations:

- Endorse the application for a Forward Planning CSRFF grant of \$1,000,000 for redevelopment of the Indoor Sports Stadium, this is a Department of Sport and Recreation funding program designed to assist in the development of infrastructure for sport and recreation.
- Council are requested to waive fees for stall holders permits for local businesses to participate in the Garage Sale Trail. This is an opportunity to encourage all sectors of the community to be a part of this positive event which is occurring on a retail day.
- Endorse the submission by the Esperance Equestrian Club for a Small Grants application to the CSRFF grant of \$9611 to erect a shed to store equipment trailers, Council have already allocated a matching amount through the 2016/17 Community Grants Program.
- Reassignment of an existing lease on Mobile Food Van Site No 2 from Esperance Bakery Food Van to Spudicious.
- Development Applications for variations on a private development in West Beach and a realignment of reserves along Twilight Beach Road to incorporate existing road reserves
- Behind Closed doors: Review of Local Planning Strategy and Demolition of the Tanker Jetty
