Asphalt works

Over the next 4 weeks the Shire will be carrying out asphalt works on roads and footpaths in town and there will be traffic management in place. Sections of the following roads and footpaths have been scheduled to be completed in this year's budget.

Roads: Banksia Street, Gull Street, Padbury Street, Symons Street, Castletown Quays, Simpson Street, Mitchell Street, Easton Road, The Esplanade, Dempster Street, Beckwith Street, Cherrywell/Downes Street, Langham Lane, McCudden Street, Gladston Street, Jane Street, James/Dempster Street, Dempster/Brazier Intersection, Chaplin Street (East Lane) and Wylie Bay/Bandy Creek Road.

Footpaths: Norseman Road, Easton Road, Walnut Road, Lalor Park, Downes Street, Pink Lake Road, Foreshore, Forrest Street, Dempster/Andrew Street footpath crossings, Goldfields Road/Castletown IGA, Smith Street Footpath – Twilight Beach Road and Castletown Quays.

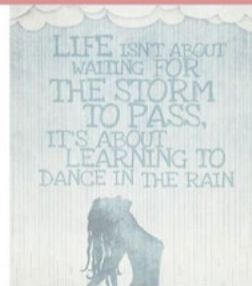
