## Potential Site for New Waste Facility

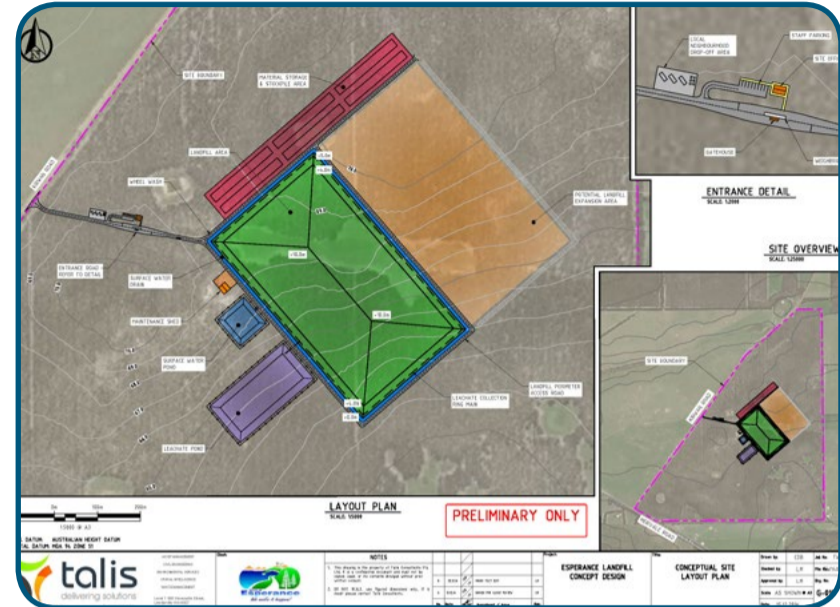
A potential new Waste Facility Site will undergo further intensive testing after passing initial tests. Council has entered into a preliminary contract for a site located in the Merivale region.

The Wylie Bay facility will need to cease operations by August 2019, so the new facility will need to be up and running by then.

Access to the site will be restricted to authorised vehicles, once operational. The general public will still be able to access the Wylie Bay Waste Facility. Verge side collections will go to the new facility.

The new facility will meet DER and EPA requirements and have no environmental impact. It will have no visual, noise, litter or ground water impact and there will be minimal signage.

There has been some interest in starting a community focus group with surrounding land owners as local knowledge will help to gain information on the proposed site.

## What is Prohibited Burning?



The Shire has different burning restrictions corresponding to different times and conditions during the year. Currently we are in a Prohibited Burning Time; this means no fires are to be lit in the open air during this time. This is from 1 November to 31 January. A Restricted Burning Time comes into effect from 19 September to 31 October and 1 February to 15 March and a permit is required to burn during this period. Unrestricted Burning Time is from 16 March to 18 September and fires can be lit without a permit, but it is common courtesy to notify your neighbours that you are burning.

All Burning Restrictions may be altered in response to current conditions. You can find updated information on our website. During the Prohibited Burning Period properties with land under 2000 square metres are required to remove all flammable material, and properties with land over 2000 square metres are required to have a low fuel buffer.
