## From the Ordinary Council Meeting

Ordinary Council Meetings are always open to the public and provide an opportunity for members of the public to ask questions. Last month's Ordinary Council Meeting took place on Tuesday 28 November resolving to:

- Develop a Waste Education Strategy and an Implementation Plan and Business Case to include conceptual designs and cost estimates for an organics processing facility
- To waive the ratepayer's portion of rates for a centenarian
- Approve the development application for Lucky Bay Brewery for a period of two years subject to conditions
- Refuse the issuance of a traders permit at the West Beach carpark and research all suitable locations for temporary traders permits
- Amend the 2017/18 budget to enable a feasibility and business case comparison of potential Visitor Centre location/s within the James Street Precinct as compared to the current Visitor Centre location to be undertaken
