
## Draft Concept Design - Replacement Jetty

We would like your feedback on the Draft Concept Design for a Replacement Jetty! The Draft was developed by H+H Architects, following initial stakeholder consultation and a review of all existing information and consultation about the Esperance Tanker Jetty and Replacement Jetty.

The draft concept would comprise three different jetty bent types including an historic section that references the Old Tanker Jetty design, plus a long concrete fishing jetty that terminates in a wide Jetty Head at the seaward end, with a dive platform below. The length of the proposed design will have a steel balustrade on one side, and a traditional timber balustrade on the other, with a mixture of timber and concrete decking, inlaid with a steel track that interprets the original railway line. The jetty will have raked piles for its length and will feature a fish-cleaning station, bench seating and visitor shelters, as well as interpretative nodes that honour the history of the Tanker Jetty.

The design is open for a 21 day comment period starting from today. You can complete a written submission or opt in to a survey which will be available online and in print. The survey will also be sent to 2000 randomly selected households, if you receive one of these please fill in your answers in and return in the reply paid envelope even if you have already completed the survey online. The two surveys will be recorded independently of each other.

## From the Ordinary Council meeting

Ordinary Council Meetings are always open to the public and provide an opportunity to ask questions. This week's Ordinary Council Meeting took place on Tuesday 28 August with Council resolving to:

- Commit \$1,495,601 for the supply and installation of twelve road grids, including the associated road and signage works, for the Esperance Extension to the State Barrier Fence project. This commitment is over four years, starting in the 2019/20 financial year, and will be part of the annual road construction program
- Accept the management of Reserve 35069 and agree to continued usage by the Cascade Primary School at agreed dates and times.
- Endorse the CSRFF Small Grant Funding applications
- Waive the fees associated with utilising the Civic Centre for the memorial Service to be held in honour of the late Rev. Douglas Murray (OAM).
