## Dempster Head Management Plan

The Draft Dempster Head Management Plan 2018 was received by Council at the March Ordinary Council Meeting and is now open public comment until 4pm, Friday 27 April 2018.

South Coast Natural Resource Management was engaged to undertake key works to review and update the 2003 Dempster Head Management Plan to reflect current conditions and provide clear direction on the future management of the reserve.

The draft document is available for review at the Administration Building or on the Shire website. Submissions must be made in writing addressed to the CEO.

## Fencing Local Law

Last year, a review of the *Fencing Local Law 2002* was undertaken, as required under the *Local Government Act s3.12* and it found that some changes were required. The *Fencing Local Law 2018* has been drafted to be simpler and consistent with higher legislation, including the newly endorsed Local Planning Scheme 24 and the Building Act 2011 and Regulations. The creation of the Fencing Local Law 2018 will repeal its predecessor, the Fencing Local Law 2002 (amended 2011).

The draft Local Law can be downloaded from the Shire website. Public submissions are welcome and should be addressed to the Chief Executive Officer and posted to PO Box 507, Esperance WA. The submission period closes at 4pm, 25 May 2018.
